

Man Murders Wife Then Commits Suicide

(Dickinson) Police say the body of 41 year old Jamie Osborn was found by passers-by in a wooded area in Miles City, Mont., on August 16th. Police say he died of an apparent self-inflicted gunshot wound. The body of Osborn's 43 year old wife, Tracey, was found the following Monday morning inside a vehicle in Dunn County, about 50 miles north of Dickinson. Tracey's neighbors state they heard the couple arguing in the driveway Sunday, August 16th, shortly before her death.

In July, Osborn had been arrested for terrorizing and aggravated assault charges after he allegedly cut his wife's throat.

Tracey leaves behind one daughter and two sons. She enjoyed darts, socializing, cooking, bowling and golf. She also loved to be outdoors camping, boating and hiking. Tracey's main love was for her children, grandchildren and family.
